



HEALTH MONITORING & MANAGEMENT

The following measures will be in effect when classes resume at CIS:

- All people entering the school building (including staff, students and parents) must wear a face mask and have their body temperature checked.
- Temperature checking stations will be set up every day and anyone entering the school will have their temperature checked by school staff:
- Temperature check stations set up at the main and bus entrances.
- A normal temperature reading is 37 degrees a fever is considered to be above 37.5 degrees or higher.
- Anyone with a fever will not be able to enter the school and will be sent home and advised to seek medical attention as soon as possible.
 - Staff, parents and visitors entering the school will be required to complete the government's '14-day Travel Declaration' form before starting school, until further notified.

The health of staff and students will be monitored daily;

- Students will follow regular attendance and registration procedures.
- Staff will use regular absence reporting in Gibbon.
- Absences due to sickness may be reported daily.

If a staff member, student or parent is sick:

- Do not come to work/school staff and students will book a sick day.
- Wear a mask to prevent further spread.
- Consult a doctor or get medical attention as necessary.
- If showing the symptoms of COVID, you must seek immediate medical attention,

report the illness to the school, and present a health certificate before returning to the school. If a student or staff member has a concern about their temperature during the school day, they will go directly to the School Nurse. All students, staff, parents and visitors can take off their masks when they arrive at school. If they are required to wear masks throughout the school day, it must be worn in all work spaces and classrooms, while on campus.

All students, staff, parents and visitors will do their best to avoid large group gatherings while on the school campus. No loitering on the school campus will be permitted.

All students, staff, parents and visitors are requested to practice good hand hygiene frequently (soap and water for 20 seconds when possible, otherwise alcohol hand rub) and avoid touching the mouth, nose and eyes.

Accommodations will be made where necessary or required to ensure social distancing is practised.
